**Application for an Electricity Retailer Licence (Third Party
Generator – Net Metering Only to Large Volume
Consumers Only)**

Decision and Order

On April 11, 2025, Hwisel Soft Inc. (Hwisel) filed a complete application with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) under section 60 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* (OEB Act) for an electricity retailer licence to retail electricity as a “third party generator” for net metering to large volume consumers only. The licence would allow the applicant to retail electricity as a third party generator for net metering purposes to large volume consumers only in Ontario

“Third party generator” is defined in section 2 of Ontario Regulation 389/10, (General), made under the Energy Consumer Protection Act, 2010 to mean:

a supplier who retails electricity produced by a renewable energy generation facility and who is an eligible third party generator within the meaning of Ontario Regulation 541/05 (Net Metering) made under the Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998. (Net Metering Regulation)

Hwisel seeks to retail electricity generated by a renewable generation facility under a power purchase agreement only to large volume consumers who are “eligible customers” as defined in the Net Metering Regulation and who enter into a net metering agreement with their electricity distributor.

This Decision and Order is being issued by the Delegated Authority without a hearing pursuant to section 6(4) of the OEB Act.

After considering the evidence and assessing the technical capability and financial viability of the applicant, the OEB finds that it is in the public interest to grant the application and issue a third party generator (net metering only) electricity retailer licence (large volume consumers only) to Hwisel. The licence authorizes Hwisel, solely for the purpose of retailing renewable electricity to eligible customers who are net metered in accordance with the requirements of the Net Metering Regulation. In the event that Hwisel at some later date wishes to retail electricity to consumers other than in accordance with the Net Metering Regulation, Hwisel will require an amendment to its electricity retailer licence to include such authorization.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The application by Hwisel Soft Inc. for a third-party generator (net metering only) electricity retailer licence (large volume consumers only) is granted, on such conditions as are contained in the attached licence.
