DECISION AND ORDER

1149377 Ontario Limited (1149377 Ontario) filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) on May 5, 2025, under section 60 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* (OEB Act) for an electricity generation licence.

This Decision and Order is being issued by the Delegated Authority, pursuant to Section 6 of the OEB Act. The Delegated Authority has considered the application without holding a hearing pursuant to section 6(4) of the OEB Act.

The applicant was previously licensed by the OEB as an electricity generator, however its licence expired on January 1, 2024. 1149377 Ontario acknowledges that it has been operating hydroelectric generation facilities without a licence since January 1, 2024. The licence is required for the purpose of generating electricity for sale.

After considering the application and assessing the technical capability and financial viability of the applicant, the OEB finds that it is in the public interest to grant the application and issue an electricity generation licence to 1149377 Ontario Limited. Applicants are reminded of the importance to apply for renewal of any licence sufficiently prior to the expiry date to allow for processing of the application. The granting of this licence is without prejudice to any future compliance action regarding 1149377 Ontario's operating without a licence.

1. The application is granted, on such conditions as are contained in the attached licence.
