DECISION AND ORDER

Domtar Inc. filed an application on June 11, 2025, with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) pursuant to section 60 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* (OEB Act), for an electricity wholesaler licence. The applicant's licence EW-2020-0128 expired on June 10, 2025.

Licensees are reminded to submit their renewal applications before their licence's expiry date to ensure compliance with section 57 of the OEB Act. The granting of this licence is without prejudice to any future compliance action regarding Domtar Inc.'s operating without a valid licence.

This Decision and Order is being issued by the Delegated Authority pursuant to section 6 of the OEB Act. The Delegated Authority has considered the application without holding a hearing pursuant to section 6(4) of the OEB Act.

After considering the application and assessing the technical capability and financial viability of the applicant, the OEB finds that it is in the public interest to grant the application and issue an electricity wholesaler licence to Domtar Inc.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The application is granted, on such conditions as are contained in the attached licence.
