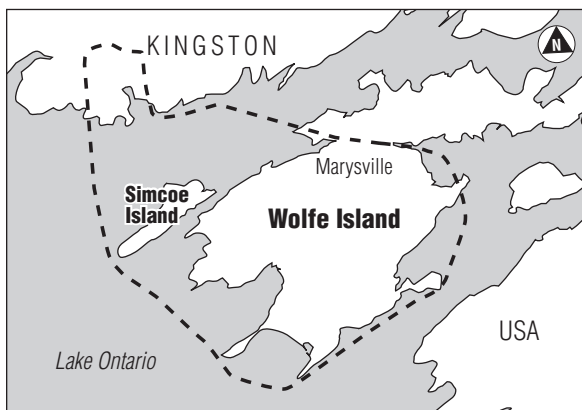

# Notice of Modification to an Environmental Screening WOLFE ISLAND WIND PROJECT

Canadian Hydro Developers, Inc. ("Canadian Hydro"), through its wholly owned subsidiary Canadian Renewable Energy Corporation and in association with the Ontario Wind Energy Partners Limited Partnership ("OWEP"), which is a Limited Partnership consisting of Gaia Power, Inc. (Kingston, ON), Skypower Corp. (Toronto, ON), and Citizens Energy Corporation (Boston, MASS), is proposing to develop a wind plant on Wolfe and Simcoe Islands in the Township of Frontenac Islands, near Kingston, Ontario.

As originally conceived, Canadian Hydro and OWEP were pursuing two independent wind projects. However, in the interest of increasing competitiveness and minimizing costs, the two Companies have decided to develop one, integrated project. It is intended that Canadian Hydro will be the project lead.

Thus, on the basis of an integrated project, Canadian Hydro and OWEP are proposing to develop a wind plant designed to generate between 150 to 200 megawatts ("MW") of renewable energy. Depending upon the final wind turbine configuration, 65 to 135 turbines would be placed strategically throughout the general area of study (see figure). A power line, substation, and other ancillary facilities are also proposed as part of the project and will assist in connecting the project electrically to the mainland.

Canadian Hydro has retained Acres International Limited ("Acres") to prepare an Environmental Screening Report ("ESR") as required under Ontario Regulation 116/01 of the *Environmental Assessment Act*. The ESR is being completed as required for a Category B project under the Ministry of the Environment's Environmental Screening Process for electricity projects as outlined in their "Guide to Environmental Assessment Requirements for Electricity Projects (March 2001)".

As applicable, the Wolfe Island Wind Project will also have regard for federal requirements. Canadian Hydro and Acres will work with the appropriate federal agencies to ensure the project meets the requirements for a screening level study under the *Canadian Environmental Assessment Act*.

At this time Acres is finalizing the ESR based upon an integrated project between Canadian Hydro and OWEP, which will be made available to stakeholders for review and comment. In the interim, in order to ensure that the appropriate environmental protection measures are incorporated into the project design, your input and questions are encouraged. Canadian Hydro Developers, Inc. (“Canadian Hydro”), through its wholly owned subsidiary Canadian Renewable Energy Corporation, and in association with the Ontario Wind Energy Partners Limited Partnership (“OWEP”), is proposing to develop a wind plant on Wolfe and Simcoe Islands in the Township of Frontenac Islands, near Kingston, Ontario. The attached Notice of Modification provides more detail regarding the proposal.

As originally conceived, Canadian Hydro and OWEP were pursuing two independent wind projects. The project is subject to the Ministry of the Environment’s Environmental Screening Process for Electricity Projects, under the Electricity Projects Regulation (ON. Reg. 116/01) of the Ontario *Environmental Assessment Act*. It is also subject to federal environmental screening requirements, under the *Canadian Environmental Assessment Act*.

The environmental screening work that has been completed to date for the original independent projects will be updated such that a single body of documentation will be produced to satisfy provincial and federal environmental screening requirements for the integrated project.

To assist our study, and to ensure that appropriate environmental protection measures are incorporated into the project design, we ask that you provide us with any comments or issues relevant to this undertaking by September 15, 2005.
