NOTICE OF COMPLETION OF AN ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW REPORT

Wolfe Island Wind Project

Canadian Renewable Energy Corporation ("CREC"), a wholly owned subsidiary of Canadian Hydro Developers, Inc., is proposing to develop a wind plant on Wolfe Island, in the Township of Frontenac Islands, near Kingston, Ontario (see map). CREC has secured a Renewable Energy Supply II Contract with the Ontario Power Authority for this project.

As proposed, the Wolfe Island Wind Project will consist of 86 wind turbines strategically placed throughout the western portion of the Island and will have a nameplate capacity of 197.8 megawatts. Key ancillary features on Wolfe Island and the City of Kingston include access roads, transformer station, pad mounted transformers, operations and maintenance building, interconnection at Hydro One's Gardiners Transformer Station, and collector and transmission power lines.

CREC retained Stantec Consulting Ltd. ("Stantec") to complete the Environmental Screening Process ("ESP"), as required under the Ontario Regulation 116/01 of the *Environmental Assessment Act*. The project has been assessed through the ESP as required for a Category B project under the Ministry of the Environment's Guide to Environmental Assessment Requirements for Electricity Projects, March 2001 ("EA Guide"). Following the EA Guide, the Project was assessed through an Environmental Review Report ("ERR"). Additionally, the ERR considered federal requirements and the *Canadian Environmental Assessment Act*; in accordance with the Canada-Ontario Agreement on Environmental Assessment Harmonization.

The results of the ERR indicate that overall, the Project as a whole is not likely to cause significant net environmental effects, taking into account the implementation of appropriate protection and mitigation measures. As such, CREC intends to proceed with the project. The ratings of the significance of net environmental effects documented in the ERR range from minimal to medium.

In compliance with Ontario Regulation 116/01 the ERR must be made available for a minimum 30 calendar day review period. 


