DECISION AND ORDER

Integrated Gas Recovery Services Inc. filed a complete application with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) on May 28, 2025, under section 60 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* (OEB Act) for a renewal of its electricity generation licence. The applicant's licence EG-2005-0212 expired on April 17, 2025.

This Decision and Order is being issued by the Delegated Authority, pursuant to Section 6 of the OEB Act. The Delegated Authority has considered the application without holding a hearing pursuant to section 6(4) of the OEB Act.

Integrated Gas Recovery Services Inc. owns two generation facilities located in Mississauga and Niagara Falls, Ontario.

After considering the technical and financial capability of the applicant, the OEB finds that it is in the public interest to grant the application and issue the electricity generation licence to Integrated Gas Recovery Services Inc. The OEB notes the application was filed by the applicant 41 days after the expiration of the existing licence. Applicants are reminded of the importance to apply for renewal of any licence sufficiently prior to the expiry date to allow for processing of the application. The granting of this licence is without prejudice to any future compliance action regarding Integrated Gas Recovery Services Inc.'s operating without a valid licence.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The application is granted, on such conditions as are contained in the attached licence.
