2. (h) Please describe the applicant's current or intended line of business and business activities.

The applicant will acquire Domtar Inc.'s Espanola, Ontario property, including previously operating pulp and paper mill facilities and existing hydroelectricity generating assets. The Domtar paper mill was idled in 2023. The applicant's plans for the acquired property are currently under development. Continued processing of forest products, including for paper and/or new kinds of biofuels, is under consideration, along with other electricity intensive uses on the property. In the interim, the applicant will continue operating the acquired generation facilities, using some of the output from those facilities on site and selling the balance into the IESO-administered market.
