Re: Invitation to Attend an Engagement Session on the OEB-IESO Joint Study of DER Compensation Mechanisms

The Ontario Energy Board (OEB) is inviting stakeholders to attend an engagement session this month to discuss a study that the OEB and Independent Electricity System Operator (IESO) jointly commissioned about compensation mechanisms for distributed energy resources (DERs).

## **Background**

The OEB and IESO have released <u>Assessment of Ontario's DER Compensation</u> <u>Mechanisms and Recommendations</u>, a study examining how compensation mechanisms for DERs can work together to enable better design and alignment moving forward. The study lays out a suite of considerations for the OEB and IESO, the goal of which is to maximize the economically efficient adoption and operation of DERs.

The purpose of the OEB-IESO engagement session is to:

- Present the results of the study and recommendations.
- Provide an update on OEB and IESO initiatives that are responsive to the recommendations.
- Provide an update on the Ministry of Energy and Mines' Integrated Energy Plan implementation directives to the OEB and IESO, which set out actions to support cost-effective DER integration, including in areas related to the study's recommendations.
