**Re: Supplemental Decision on Working Group Membership – Distribution  
Customer Connections Review (EB-2025-0204)**

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On July 31, 2024, the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) issued a [letter](#) regarding Working Group (WG) membership in respect of the Distribution Customer Connections (DCC) Review. In the same letter, the OEB approved cost eligibility for a number of stakeholders.

On August 5, 2025, the OEB received a late request for WG membership and cost eligibility from Consumers Council of Canada (CCC). While CCC's request for WG membership was submitted past the deadline of July 21, 2025, the OEB accepts CCC as a member.

In its July 3<sup>rd</sup> kickoff [letter](#) for the DCC Review, the OEB stated that any participant determined to be eligible for costs in the OEB's System Expansions for Housing Developments consultation (EB-2024-0092) and EV Charging Connections Subgroup, under the DER Connections Review consultation (EB-2019-0207) is deemed eligible for costs in relation to their participation in the DCC WG. CCC was eligible for costs in EB-2024-0092 and is therefore eligible for costs in the current proceeding.

Participants in this consultation are reminded of the importance of adhering to OEB-imposed deadlines.
