## LETTER OF COMMENT

### Comments:

I strongly oppose Enbridge Gas proposed 2026 rate hike for Union South under OEB file number EB 2025 0163. Ontario families face rising costs and another increase of about 35 dollars a year will hurt households. No one should have to choose between heat and groceries. Enbridge reports record profits near 6 billion last year and paid its chief executive about 18 million. As a monopoly with a growing customer base, Enbridge should deliver efficiencies, not higher rates. The inflation formula does not justify more charges when productivity gains and profits can cover costs. Customers report inaccurate estimates and rising fixed charges, eroding trust. Last year the province overrode an OEB decision with Bill 165, forcing existing customers to subsidize new pipelines at about 600 dollars per household. Communities and intervenors have pushed back before, and the OEB has reduced unnecessary spending to protect consumers. Please reject this increase, require tighter cost control and real productivity improvements, and put affordability first.
