Issues:

Pollution Probe represents a consumer and policy interest related to Enbridge's 2026 rate application. The application relates to 2026 rates in compliance with the OEB approvals and conditionals granted for the 2024-2028 rate term. Pollution Probe was a party to the settlement agreement approved by the OEB which applies to this 2026 application. Additionally, the draft Issues List Enbridge included in the application identifies reallocation of \$50 million of overhead capital to O&M as required to align with current accounting principles and reduce stranded asset risks associated with over-capitalisation of overhead costs. Additional related conditions were included in the OEB approved settlement agreement that pertains to this application.
