- **Dan Gapic is a Chartered Professional Accountant, CMA, has worked in the electricity distribution industry overseeing the Accounting/Regulatory Accounting functions with 5 local distribution companies since 1991, has worked with the OEB in the role, Manager of Incentive Rate Setting and Regulatory Accounting from 2016 to 2020, along with a strong demonstrated working knowledge of the APH. While at the OEB Dan led the Regulatory Accounting team to establish the OEB's Accounting Guidance related to the Commodity Pass through accounts establishing the RPP Settlement Processes that electricity distributors implemented. Dan also led the Regulatory Accounting team to develop the GA Analysis Workform, and led the issuance of a number of regulatory accounting guidance documents approved by the OEB that were implemented by electricity distributors. Before joining the OEB Dan actively participated in the working group and contributed to the establishment of the guidance**

related to reporting of the Regulated ROE in the RRR, 2.5.6.

- **Daniel Smith is a Chartered Professional Accountant and has completed a review and update of all USofA chart of accounts at a previous utility and has participated in corporate cost allocation at a previous utility. He has a strong understanding of the functions of the USofA accounts, Articles 210, 220, 230, 240, 315, 330, 340, 410, 475, and 490, regulatory accounting pertaining to the commodity pass through accounts, and RPP settlement with the IESO.**
