Issues:

Energy Probe is materially affected as its members and supporters are customers of the Applicant. It was a party to the settlement agreement which applies to this application. The following three issues will be the subject of Energy Probe's intervention. 1. Is the base rate adjustment moving \$50 million of overhead capital to O&M calculated properly? 2. Is the proposed price cap rate adjustment for 2026 calculated properly? 3. Are the proposed Y-factor pass-through costs included in 2026 rates for each of the EGD and Union Rate Zones appropriate?

Policy Interests:

The capitalization of overhead costs has been a policy interest of Energy Probe for many years. It is possible that Issue 1 will deal with overhead capitalization policy.

Hearings:

Energy Probe does not have a reason for having a specific form of hearing.

Evidence:

Energy probe does not plan to file evidence.

Coordination with Other Intervenors:

Energy Probe intends to co-ordinate with other intervenors to avoid any potential duplication, where several intervenors ask same or similar interrogatories. Where possible, Energy Probe intends to share drafts of interrogatories and submissions with other intervenors.

Cost Awards:

Energy Probe applies for recovery of its reasonably incurred costs during its intervention in this proceeding. Energy Probe is a non-profit organization which relies on individual donations to help protect the public interest. Without the prospect of an award of costs, Energy Probe's ability to participate in OEB proceedings would be limited. Energy Probe's members and supporters are customers of the Applicant and eligible for an award of costs according to section 3.03(a) of the Practice Direction. Energy Probe has participated in many past natural gas and electricity proceedings in Ontario, including consultations, rate cases, and other processes and hearings, and has been found eligible to be paid its reasonably incurred costs.

Language Preference:

Energy Probe does not intend to participate using the French language.
