DECISION AND ORDER

Enersource Hydro Mississauga (“Enersource” or the “Applicant”) filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board (the “Board”), dated October 10, 2008 seeking approval for a timeline extension to complete third tranche spending of its approved Conservation and Demand Management (“CDM”) plan. Enersource has also requested, pursuant to subsection 21(4)(b) of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* (the “Act”) that the Board dispose of the proceeding without a hearing. The Board assigned file number EB-2008-0331 to this application.

On February 3, 2005, Enersource was granted approval of its CDM plan (RP-2004-0203/EB-2004-0489). The total approved budget for Enersource’s CDM plan is \$8,263,000 with \$113,000 currently unspent.

On July 30, 2008 Enersource was granted approval to extend the completion date to exhaust third tranche CDM expenditures from December 31, 2007 to September 1, 2008 (EB-2008-0108).

Enersource has further requested an extension to complete spending of approved third tranche funds from September 1, 2008 to December 31, 2008.

Enersource has requested that the Board dispose of this matter without a hearing pursuant to section 21(4)(b) of the Act. Section 21(4)(b) of the Act states that the Board may dispose of a proceeding without a hearing if the Board determines that “*no person, other than the applicant, appellant or licence holder will be adversely affected in a material way by the outcome of the proceeding and the applicant, appellant or licence holder has consented to disposing of a proceeding without a hearing.*”

The Board approves the timeline extension as proposed by Enersource.

THE BOARD ORDERS THAT:

Enersource Hydro Mississauga is granted approval to extend the completion date to exhaust third tranche CDM expenditures from September 1, 2008 to December 31, 2008.
