



**Elexicon Energy Inc.**

**Application for electricity distribution rates and other  
charges effective January 1, 2026**

**PROCEDURAL ORDER NO. 1  
September 3, 2025**

Elexicon Energy Inc. (Elexicon Energy) filed an incentive rate-setting mechanism (IRM) application with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) on July 16, 2025, under section 78 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, seeking approval for changes to its electricity distribution rates for the Veridian Rate Zone and the Whitby Rate Zone effective **January 1, 2026**. Elexicon Energy has also requested funding for an Incremental Capital Module (ICM) to rebuild the Sandy Beach Substation and for the installation of a new Dual Element Spot Network.

The application will be heard by commissioners: Allison Duff (presiding), Robert Dodds, and Shahrzad Rahbar.

A Notice of Hearing was issued on August 6, 2025. Power Workers' Union (PWU) applied for intervenor status. Coalition of Concerned Manufacturers and Businesses of Canada (CCMBC), Consumers Council of Canada (CCC), Environmental Defence, School Energy Coalition (SEC), and Vulnerable Energy Consumers Coalition (VECC), applied for intervenor status and cost eligibility.

No objection was received from Elexicon Energy.

PWU is approved as an intervenor. CCMBC, CCC, Environmental Defence, SEC, and VECC are approved as intervenors and are eligible to apply for an award of costs under the OEB's [Practice Direction on Cost Awards](#). The list of parties in this proceeding is attached as Schedule A to this Procedural Order.

Cost eligible intervenors should be aware that the OEB will not generally allow the recovery of costs for the attendance of more than one representative of any party unless a compelling reason is provided when cost claims are filed.

The OEB is making provision for the following related to this proceeding. Further procedural orders may be issued by the OEB.

**THE ONTARIO ENERGY BOARD ORDERS THAT:**

1. OEB staff and intervenors shall request any relevant information and documentation from Elexicon Energy that is in addition to the evidence already filed, by written interrogatories filed with the OEB and served on Elexicon Energy and all other parties by **September 18, 2025**.
2. Elexicon Energy shall file with the OEB complete written responses to the interrogatories and serve them on all intervenors by **October 3, 2025**.
3. Any written submissions by OEB staff and intervenors shall be filed with the OEB and served on all other parties by **October 21, 2025**.
4. Elexicon Energy may file a written reply submission with the OEB and serve it on intervenors by **November 4, 2025**.

Parties are responsible for ensuring that any documents they file with the OEB, such as applicant and intervenor evidence, interrogatories and responses to interrogatories or any other type of document, **do not include personal information** (as that phrase is defined in the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act*), unless filed in accordance with rule 9A of the OEB's [Rules of Practice and Procedure](#).
