- 7. VECC requests that copies of the Application and any additional supporting materials be forwarded to each of the two parties named above.
- 8. VECC is intervening in order to ensure that consumer interests and in particular the interests of the low-income and vulnerable users of natural gas are fully represented in the development of Natural Gas Demand Side Management Guidelines.
- 9. VECC has established a long-standing interest and history in the development of demand side management policy and programs within the OEB regulatory context, including active participation in the EB-2006-0021 process. Additionally VECC has worked actively with natural gas distributors in the ongoing implementation and evaluation of their respective DSM programs, including providing a VECC representative for the EGDI DSM Evaluation and Audit committee (EAC). VECC has also maintained a consistent and fully participatory role in Board (and non-Board) processes related to Conservation and Demand Management in the electricity sector on behalf of vulnerable and low income consumers.

Additionally, VECC's consultants are very familiar with Gas and Electricity DSM/CDM programs across multiple Jurisdictions.

VECC will be requesting an award of costs for its participation in this
proceeding and believes that it meets the eligibility criteria set out in the
Ontario Energy Board's Rules of Practice and Procedure and its Practice
Direction on Cost Awards.
