As a Local Distribution Company, NT Power is regulated by the [Ontario Energy Board \(OEB\)](#), a crown corporation responsible for overseeing the province's electricity and natural gas sectors and its participants. NT Power requires a licence from the OEB. A licence permits energy companies to operate in Ontario and outlines the laws, rules, and regulatory requirements they must follow. NT Power's rate applications must be approved through a complex hearing process from the OEB. The OEB also sets the prices for Regulated Price Plan electricity rates and approves the rates for distribution/delivery and transmission. In short, they are the regulatory policymakers, and it is our job to inform you of our regulatory activities.

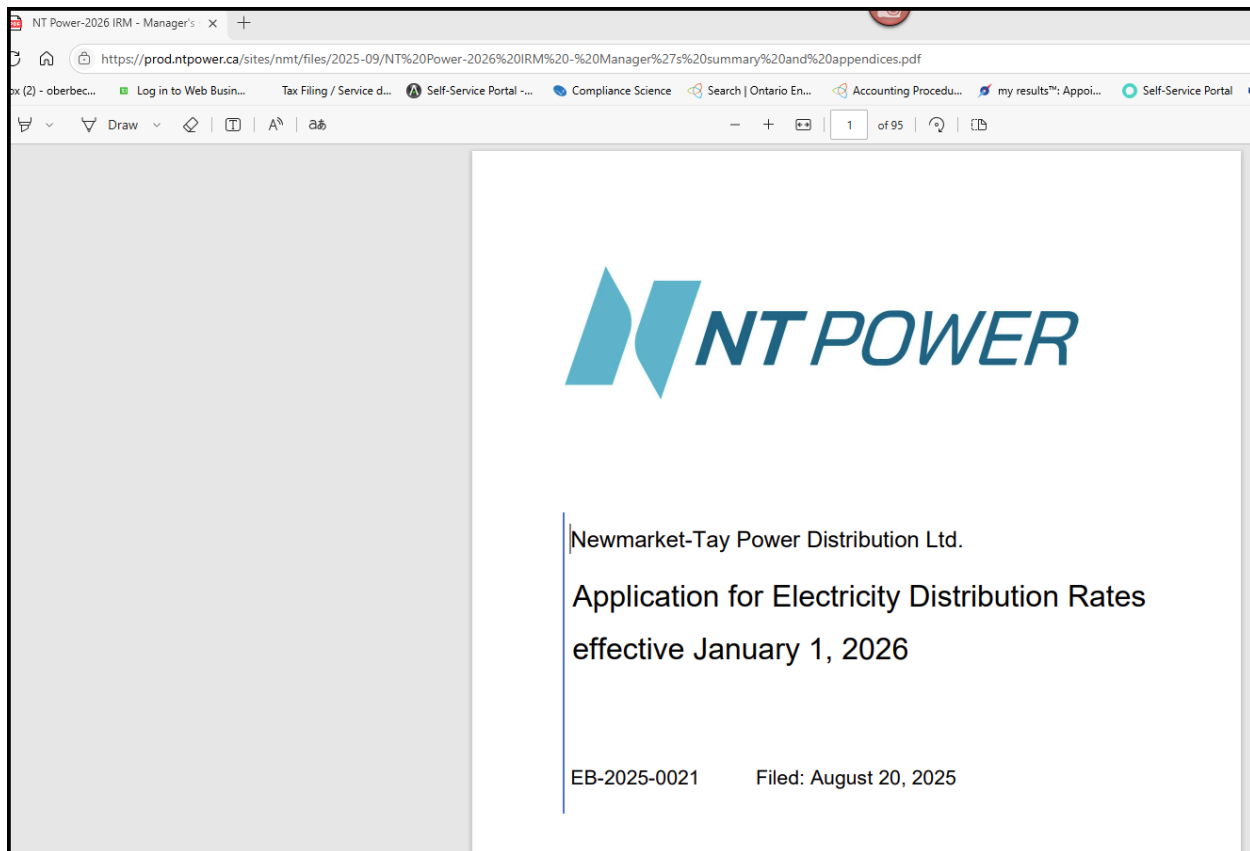

NOTICE OF A RATE HEARING

Newmarket-Tay Power Distribution Ltd. has applied to change its electricity distribution rates effective January 1, 2026

Newmarket-Tay Power Distribution Ltd. (NT Power) has applied to the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) to change its electricity distribution rates effective January 1, 2026.

The requested rate adjustment is determined using an OEB-approved formula, which is tied to inflation and other factors intended to promote efficiency. If the application is approved as filed, a typical residential customer and a typical general service customer of NT Power would see the following changes:


Customer Class	Newmarket-Tay Rate Zone	Midland Rate Zone
Residential (750 kWh)	(\$.29) per month	\$1.48 per month
General Service less than 50kW (2000 kWh)	(\$.16) per month	\$1.12 per month

Other customers, including businesses, will also be affected. It's important to review the application carefully to determine whether you may be affected by the proposed changes.

NT Power has also requested:

- Approval for Z-factor fixed rate riders affecting both rate zones, related to a severe ice storm that occurred on March 29, 2025

This hearing will be held under section 78 of the **Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998**.
