**Re: Ontario Power Generation Inc. (“OPG”) Request for Approval of
Amendment to Must Offer Condition Agreement
Ontario Energy Board File No.: EB-2025-0253**

The Ontario Energy Board (OEB) received OPG’s application for approval of an amendment to the Must Offer Condition Agreement, which is a condition of its electricity generation licence EG-2023-0231 on August 19, 2025. The OEB has commenced processing the application and has assigned it file number EB-2025-0253.
