Application for an Electricity Wholesaler Licence

INTERIM DECISION AND ORDER

Alamos Gold Inc. (Alamos Gold) filed an application on September 8, 2025, with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) pursuant to section 60 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* (OEB Act), for a renewal of its electricity wholesaler licence.

Alamos Gold's electricity wholesaler licence EW-2020-0199 is set to expire on September 16, 2025. In order for the applicant to continue providing electricity wholesaler services in Ontario, the applicant requires an electricity wholesaler licence pursuant to section 57 of the OEB Act.

Considering the time required to process an application in accordance with the OEB's established practice and procedures, and considering the applicant's need for a licence to carry out activities as an electricity wholesaler, the OEB finds it expedient to extend the term of the existing licence, pending the final disposition of the matter. This Decision and Order does not constitute a final decision on the application.

The applicant is reminded that it carries the onus of filing an application in a timely manner considering the OEB's typical timelines for processing licence applications.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The term of Alamos Gold Inc.'s electricity wholesaler licence EW-2020-0199 is extended on an interim basis until December 11, 2025, or until the final determination of the electricity wholesaler licence application, whichever is earlier. The conditions of licence remain unchanged.
