**Re: Enbridge Gas Inc. 2024 Rebasing Application – Phase 3
Status of Settlement Discussions
Ontario Energy Board (OEB) File No. EB-2025-0064**

In its Decision on Confidentiality and Procedural Order No. 3, the OEB made provision for a settlement conference that was to be held from September 8-10, 2025. The OEB further determined that, given the collective scope and range of the interests represented by the intervenors, it was not necessary for OEB staff to attend or participate in the settlement conference beyond technical staff required to support the process. OEB staff was instructed to provide an update on the status of the settlement discussions between the applicant and intervenors (collectively, the parties) no later than September 10, 2025. The filing of the status letter was to be coordinated with the settlement conference facilitator.

OEB staff has been advised by Mr. Ken Rosenberg, the settlement conference facilitator, that parties would benefit from an extension to the settlement discussions until October 10, 2025. It is proposed that the parties will report to the OEB on the status of the settlement discussions on or before October 10, 2025. The intervenors have indicated that they need more time to receive and analyze information requests that are still to be provided by Enbridge Gas and continue further discussions.

The intervenors have further informed Mr. Ken Rosenberg that the extended timeline is due to other upcoming OEB proceedings. The parties are conferring to select mutually available dates for further settlement discussions. It is the opinion of Mr. Ken Rosenberg that the next four weeks will be useful for the intervenors to discuss the issues amongst themselves and collectively work with Enbridge Gas on a possible material settlement.
