Dear Cole Tavener:

**Re: Application by Sedum Master Inc. for the Approval of a Municipal Franchise Agreement with, and a limited Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity for, the Township of Blanford-Blenheim**

The Ontario Energy Board (OEB) issued its Decision and Order (Decision) for the above noted proceeding on September 2, 2025.

On September 11, 2025, Sedum Master Inc. (Sedum Master) filed a letter noting that the Certificate attached as Schedule B to the Decision did not include the full description of the limited area that is served by the Certificate, and which is also reflected in the body of the Decision. Sedum Master requested that the certificate be revised to include the updated description provided in its letter.

Pursuant to Rule 41.02 of the OEB's *Rules of Practice and Procedure*, the OEB is correcting the Certificate to include the full description of the limited area served by the Certificate. There are no other changes to the Decision.

Schedule B to this letter is the Decision with the revised Certificate dated September 16, 2025 that supersedes the version of the Decision issued on September 2, 2025.
