



Newmarket-Tay Power Distribution Ltd.

Application for electricity distribution rates and other charges effective January 1, 2026

PROCEDURAL ORDER NO. 1 September 25, 2025

Newmarket-Tay Power Distribution Ltd. (NT Power) filed an incentive rate-setting mechanism application with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) on August 20, 2025, under section 78 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act*, 1998, seeking approval for changes to its electricity distribution rates to be effective January 1, 2026. NT Power also applied for approval for Z-factor fixed rate riders affecting both rate zones, related to a severe ice storm that occurred on March 29, 2025.

The application will be heard by commissioner: Robert Dodds.

A Notice of Hearing was issued on September 3, 2025. Vulnerable Energy Consumers Coalition (VECC) applied for intervenor status and cost eligibility.

No objection was received from NT Power.

VECC is approved as an intervenor. The list of parties in this proceeding is attached as Schedule A to this Procedural Order. VECC is eligible to apply for an award of costs under the OEB's <u>Practice Direction on Cost Awards</u>.

The OEB is making provision for the following related to this proceeding. Further procedural orders may be issued by the OEB.

THE ONTARIO ENERGY BOARD ORDERS THAT:

- OEB staff and VECC shall request any relevant information and documentation from NT Power that is in addition to the evidence already filed, by written interrogatories filed with the OEB and served on NT Power by October 3, 2025.
- NT Power shall file with the OEB complete written responses to the interrogatories and serve them on VECC by October 17, 2025.
- 3. Any written submissions by OEB staff and VECC shall be filed with the OEB and

served on NT Power by October 31, 2025.

4. NT Power may file a written reply submission with the OEB and serve it on VECC by **November 14, 2025**.

Parties are responsible for ensuring that any documents they file with the OEB, such as applicant and intervenor evidence, interrogatories and responses to interrogatories or any other type of document, **do not include personal information** (as that phrase is defined in the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act*), unless filed in accordance with rule 9A of the OEB's Rules of Practice and Procedure.
