RE: EB-2025-0163 Hello OEB, I would like to formally oppose Enbridge Gas's notice to increase natural gas distribution rates. Natural gas rates already get adjusted quarterly which has occurred on July 2024, Oct 2024, Jan 2025, Apr 2025, July 2025 for example in the past year. Personally, I work in the healthcare sector where wages and reimbursement for services has not been aligned with inflation. From a year to year comparison with my most recent bill, it went from \$45.69 in July 2024 to \$65.75 in July 2025, a 44% increase. In the meantime, Enbridge's stock price has increased by 22.74% from the past year. Canada's most recent inflation rate has been reported as 1.9%. Enbridge has been generating record breaking profits by charging customers rates that surpass the inflation rate for something that is necessary to survive. Please consider revoking Enbridge's application for rate increase so that regular hardworking citizens don't continue to suffer with these absurdly high utility bills.
