

LETTER OF COMMENT

Comments:

Dear Board Members We are in receipt of Enbridge Gas Inc. Enbridge Gas application to the Ontario Energy Board OEB to change its natural gas distribution rates effective January 1, 2026, to 31.36. We are retired seniors on a fixed income. While the application cites the OEB approved formula and inflationary adjustments, we do not have the luxury to have an increase in our CPP or other social benefits based on inflation. As retirees, living within the EGD zone, we are concerned that even a modest increase will have a negative impact on our limited resources/income. We have other taxes to pay, like property taxes which keep on increasing, without any relief. We would humbly request therefore in all fairness to not allow the increase to go through and that Enbridge Inc finds efficiencies elsewhere. The application includes adjustments tied to service fees, project specific rate changes and a carbon charge adjustments. We believe these should have a rigorous scrutiny regime - it is possible and it has happened in the past that there have been major forecasting errors and assumptions that have not been correct Therefore we urge the Ontario Energy Board to: 1. Reject any rate increase that is not clearly essential and supported by robust evidence. 2. Require Enbridge to find tangible efficiencies before passing delivery or storage cost increases to customers. 3. Consider providing relief measures for fixed-income households.
