I am writing to provide a letter of comment regarding Enbridge Gas Inc.'s application to change its natural gas distribution rates, effective January 1, 2026. My concern is that this proposed rate increase places a significant burden on consumers who are already facing economic pressures. While the application states that the requested increases are based on a formula tied to inflation and other efficiency-related factors, I believe it is important for the OEB to carefully scrutinize all aspects of Enbridge's operational costs and compensation structures.
