Re: Distribution System Operator (DSO) Capabilities (EB-2025-0060) Invitation to Participate in Stakeholder Meeting

What You Need to Know

- The OEB invites stakeholders to a meeting on October 14, 2025, to advance the development of its DSO Roadmap. The OEB will post its presentation materials by October 7, 2025.
- Interested stakeholders are invited to register for the meeting by October 9, 2025.
- Written comments from stakeholders will be due October 24, 2025.

The Ontario Energy Board (OEB) invites stakeholders to a meeting on October 14, 2025, to advance the development of a DSO roadmap as part of its DSO Capabilities consultation.

Building on stakeholder feedback received in the June 2025 stakeholder symposium and in written comments received in July 2025, the OEB has developed key elements of the DSO roadmap. These include the roadmap approach, objectives, overall vision and detailed workstreams, which have been refined from the initial proposals outlined in the DSO Discussion Paper. Through this meeting, the OEB is seeking stakeholder input on these key elements to help shape the design of a practical and forward-looking roadmap.

Invitation to Participate in Stakeholder Meeting and Provide Written Comments

The OEB is holding a virtual stakeholder meeting on **October 14**, **2025**, from **1 p.m.** to **4 p.m.** To support meaningful engagement, the OEB will post a presentation deck outlining the roadmap elements and discussion questions on October 7.

During the meeting, stakeholders are encouraged to share feedback throughout the discussions. Following the meeting, stakeholders will also have the option to submit written comments by **October 24, 2025**. The OEB will be unable to extend the deadline for written comments given the requirement to submit the DSO roadmap to the Minister of Energy and Mines by December 31, 2025. Stakeholders will continue to have opportunities to contribute as the OEB moves into implementing the work defined in the DSO roadmap.

1. Eligible Activities

The activities eligible for cost awards are:

| Activities Eligible for Cost Awards | Maximum Number of Hours |

| Preparation of written comments | 5 hours |
