Re: **OEB Staff Comments on Draft Rate Order
Enbridge Gas Inc. (Enbridge Gas)
2023 Deferral and Variance Account Disposition and Earnings Sharing
OEB File Number: EB-2024-0125**

In accordance with the OEB's Decision and Order dated September 23, 2025, Enbridge Gas filed a Draft Rate Order with supporting schedules on September 29, 2025.

OEB staff has reviewed the Draft Rate Order and supporting schedules and submits that, in its reply to OEB staff and intervenor comments, Enbridge Gas should explain why the disallowance of \$3.019 million from the Getting Ontario Connected Variance Account (GOCAVA) results in higher one-time billing adjustments for some general service customers in the Union rate zone compared to the adjustments proposed in its original application¹.

OEB staff also submits that Enbridge Gas should confirm that it used the OEB's prescribed interest rates from Q1 2024 through Q4 2025 to calculate the interest to December 31, 2025.

Subject to (a) the Panel being satisfied with Enbridge Gas's explanation regarding the effect of the GOCAVA disallowance; and (b) Enbridge Gas's confirmation regarding the prescribed interest rates, OEB staff submits that the OEB should approve the Draft Rate Order as filed.
