**Re: St. Clair Transmission Line Expropriation
Ontario Energy Board File Number: EB-2025-0093**

Please find enclosed the Certificate of Approval, endorsed by the Ontario Energy Board (OEB), in accordance with the *Expropriations Act*, R.R.O. 1990, Reg. 363.

Hydro One Networks Inc. (Hydro One) applied to the OEB under s. 99 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* (OEB Act) for an order granting authority to expropriate interests in certain parcels of land to construct a 64-kilometer 230 kV transmission line in southwestern Ontario (St. Clair Transmission Line Project). On September 4, 2025, the OEB issued a Decision and Order authorizing Hydro One to expropriate permanent corridor easements on five (5) properties.

The Decision and Order required that Hydro One file with the OEB final expropriation plans for OEB endorsement as soon as practical. On September 19, 2025, Hydro One filed with the OEB final expropriation plans for the five (5) properties and requested that the OEB endorse the Certificate of Approval.

The OEB has reviewed the descriptions of the properties set out in Schedule A of the attached Certificate of Approval and confirmed that the property descriptions align with the properties approved for expropriation in the Decision and Order.
