**Re: Enbridge Gas Inc.
EB-2025-0064 – 2024 Rebasing, Phase 3**

We write on behalf of all parties to the Phase 3 Settlement Conference process in response to the OEB's September 15th letter that directed the parties to provide a progress update.

On Friday, October 10th, the mediator for the Settlement Conference, Ken Rosenberg, corresponded with OEB staff to provide an update and to request an extension of the settlement conference process. We understand that OEB staff has requested that, in addition to the emails sent by Mr. Rosenberg, a letter should be provided for the OEB.

The parties have been meeting and working diligently through the settlement conference process, with the support of the mediator (Ken Rosenberg). At this time, no tentative agreement has been reached. The parties are requesting that the OEB permit the settlement conference process to continue up to November 21, 2025.

Below is the text of the email sent by Mr. Rosenberg to OEB staff. The parties agree that this properly describes the status of the discussions and the reasons for the extension request.

The Parties met again today, all day. Today is the target date extension for this Settlement Conference.

I am providing this Confidential Update¹ as the Settlement Conference Facilitator & Mediator, with the Parties unanimous support and consent. Collectively we request a further extension of this Settlement Conference to November 21, for the reasons discussed below.

The Parties have exchanged offers on substantially all issues on the issues list; both conceptual/framing issues and granular issues.

Discussions are ongoing on all these issues, as well as between and among intervenors regarding certain zero-sum allocation issues. Plus, over the next few weeks Enbridge is

running a new, comprehensive Settlement Conference privileged analysis of certain current proposals under discussion to share and discuss with the Intervenors . Further, we have identified dates to meet in each of the next 3 weeks to carry on the Settlement Conference work.

The Parties and I believe there is real and material progress in the ongoing settlement discussions. By Friday November 21, we are collectively aiming to complete discussions and hopefully reach a material settlement.

If it would assist, the Parties can provide the OEB with a status update as to progress and prospects by November 5th.

Please let us know if you have any questions or comments.

On behalf of the Parties, we look forward to hearing from the OEB regarding an extension of this Settlement Conference to November 21.
