WDI Response to Hydro One Regarding Delay Request

Dear Mr. Murray,

We have received the Hydro One letter dated today responding to our October 23, 2025 request to file brief reply evidence, and for a modest update to the dates for the next steps in this proceeding.

Our October 23, 2025 letter should have been copied to the intervenors in this case (Hydro One and Primont Developments). We will ensure that all future filings are copied on all parties.

With respect, our request should not be controversial. It will only result in minor changes to the schedule for this case. There is no particular urgency, as the attachment of the subject development is not imminent. It is reasonable and appropriate that there be a full record for the OEB's consideration of the SAA request. Hydro One filed 18 pages of evidence/argument and there are items that demand an evidentiary response. There are other items that will be helpful to fill out the record. We will file our evidence by the beginning of next week (October 27th).

As for the timing for next steps, we note Hydro One's comments about timing. We believe that it is feasible and appropriate for interrogatories to be filed by October 31st, with responses due one week later. We acknowledge that there should be more time after interrogatory responses for argument. Having considered Hydro One's comments, we suggest that written argument be scheduled such that Wasaga Distribution provides its argument on November 14th, with Hydro One response on November 21st and Wasaga Distribution reply on November 28th.
