

NOTICE OF A RATE HEARING

Orangeville Hydro Limited has applied to change its electricity distribution rates effective May 1, 2026

Orangeville Hydro Limited (Orangeville Hydro) has applied to the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) to change its electricity distribution rates effective May 1, 2026.

The requested rate adjustment is determined using an OEB-approved formula, which is tied to inflation and other factors intended to promote efficiency. If the application is approved as filed, a typical residential customer and a typical general service customer of Orangeville Hydro would see the following changes:

Customer Class	Monthly Rate
Residential (750 kWh)	\$1.23
General Service less than 50kW (2000 kWh)	\$2.40

Other customers, including businesses, will also be affected. It's important to review the application carefully to determine whether you may be affected by the proposed changes.

Orangeville Hydro has also requested an exception to the IESO two-year limitation period to dispose certain deferral and variance accounts on an interim basis for fiscal years 2021 to 2024.¹

YOU SHOULD KNOW

There are three types of OEB hearings: oral, electronic, and written. The OEB plans to proceed with a written hearing. If you think a different hearing type is needed, you can write to us to explain why.

During this hearing, we will hear questions and arguments from participants about this case. We will also hear questions and arguments from participants that have registered as Intervenor. After the hearing, we will decide whether to approve the application.

IMPORTANT DATES

You must engage with the OEB on or before **November 14, 2025**, to:

- Provide input on the hearing type (oral, electronic, or written)
- Apply to be an intervenor

If you do not, the hearing will move forward without you, and you will not receive any further notice of the proceeding.

If you write a letter of comment, your name and the content of your letter will be put on the public record and the OEB website. If you are a business or if you apply to become an intervenor, all the information you file will be on the OEB website.
