Elexicon Energy Inc. ("Elexicon") submitted a request for confidentiality pertaining to its interrogatory responses for its 2026 IRM application (EB-2025-0046) submitted via RESS on October 3rd, 2025.

Via email on October 24, 2025, the OEB informed Elexicon that the attachments of the confidential evidence had been misidentified in their respective cover pages. To clarify the contents of the confidentiality filing, Elexicon has provided information below. Note, the names of the attachments were not deemed confidential by Elexicon in its original request, ergo, this correction can be made without altering the scope of Elexicon's initial confidentiality request.

For VECC-23 there are two attachments:

VECC-23 b), at page 7 of the Confidential filing PDF, is the Offer to Connect. This is referred to as Attachment 1 in the letter.

VECC-23 a), at page 20 of the PDF, is the Economic Evaluation. This is referred to as Attachment 2 in the letter.

For VECC-31 there is one attachment:

VECC-31 e), at page 23 of the PDF, is the Class 3 Cost Estimate, but the covering page mistakenly identifies it as the 'Economic Evaluation'. In the confidentiality request letter this is referred to as the "Class 3 Cost Estimate referenced in the CCRA". The covering page should read "VECC-31 e) Attachment: Class 3 Cost Estimate".
