
**Re: Domtar Inc.; Electricity Generation Licence EG-2011-031**

We write on behalf of Domtar Inc. (“**Domtar**”) in connection with Domtar’s Electricity Generation Licence EG-2011-031 (“**Domtar Licence**”). The Domtar Licence authorizes Domtar, *inter alia*, to generate electricity or provide ancillary services for sale through the IESO-administered markets or directly to another person, in respect of the facilities set out in Schedule 1, namely the “Espanola Mill, owned and operated by the Licensee at 1 Station Road, Espanola, Ontario” ( the “**Domtar Generating Facilities**”).

On Friday, October 17, 2025, Domtar completed the sale of the Facilities to Bioveld North Inc. (“**BNI**”). BNI holds Electricity Generation Licence EG-2025-0237 (“**BNI Licence**”) which authorizes BNI to generate electricity in respect of the facilities that are set out in Schedule 1 of the BNI Licence, namely the “EB Eddy Forest Espanola CGS generating facility located at 1 Station Road, Espanola, Ontario, P5E 1R6” ( the “**BNI Generating Facilities**”).

Although described differently in each of the Domtar Licence and the BNI Licence, the Domtar Generating Facilities and the BNI Generating Facilities are references to the same generating facilities. In light of the purchase of the Domtar Facilities by BNI, Domtar respectfully requests that the Ontario Energy Board amend the Domtar Licence by deleting the words “Espanola Mill, owned and operated by the Licensee at 1 Station Road, Espanola, Ontario”.
