Subject: Review of the Valuation of Distributed Energy Resources (EB-2025-0268).

We write on behalf of the Industrial Gas Users Association (IGUA) to register IGUA's interest in participating in the captioned review.

While IGUA represents industrial gas consumers, and the captioned review seems to relate primarily to electricity, we note that this review is one of a number of ongoing, and potentially inter-related, OEB processes which include the following:

- Enbridge Gas Inc. 2025 IRP Incentive Mechanism Application (EB-2025-0292)
- IRP Framework for Enbridge Gas Review, initiated by the OEB (EB-2025-0125)
- BCA Framework for Addressing Electricity System Needs – Phase 2 (EB-2023-0125)

Given the potentially overlapping considerations in all of these matters, and the often times application of electricity policies to regulation of natural gas services, we think it prudent for IGUA to track all of these matters, and to contribute to the OEB's policy considerations as and where appropriate.

IGUA further requests that it be determined eligible to apply for an award of its reasonably incurred costs of participation in this review, in accord with the parameters set out in Appendix A to the OEB's October 27, 2025 notification to interested parties herein. As a party primarily representing the direct interests of ratepayers in relation to services that are regulated by the Board, IGUA has historically been deemed eligible to apply for an award of its reasonably incurred costs pursuant to paragraph 3.03(a) of the OEB's *Practice Direction on Cost Awards*.
