Mississauga Reinforcement Project

Ontario Energy Board File Number: EB-2025-0073

On May 9, 2025, Enbridge Gas Inc. (Enbridge Gas) applied to the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) under section 90(1) of the *Ontario Energy Board Act*, 1998, for an order granting leave to construct approximately 3.1 kilometres of natural gas pipeline in the Town of Oakville and the City of Mississauga. Enbridge Gas also applied for approval of the form of land-use agreements related to the construction of the project.

On May 7, 2024, the Ministry of Energy and Electrification¹ (Ministry) issued its delegation letter, delegating the procedural aspects of the Crown's duty to consult in relation to the Project. Enbridge Gas stated in its application that it expects to receive a letter of opinion from the Ministry as to whether its consultation has been sufficient and will file this letter with the OEB. As of this date, Enbridge Gas has not yet filed with the OEB a letter of opinion regarding the adequacy of the Indigenous consultation undertaken by Enbridge Gas, as contemplated in the OEB's *Environmental Guidelines for the Location, Construction and Operation of Hydrocarbon Pipelines and Facilities in Ontario*.
