**Application for an Electricity Retailer Licence (With Third
Party Generator – Net Metering Authorization)**

Decision and Order

On August 29, 2025, ASI SPE 106 Inc. (ASI SPE) filed a complete application with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) under section 60 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* (OEB Act) for an electricity retailer licence with net metering authorization as a “third party generator.”

“Third party generator” is defined in section 2 of Ontario Regulation 389/10, (General), made under the *Energy Consumer Protection Act, 2010* (ECPA) to mean:

a supplier who retails electricity produced by a renewable energy generation facility and who is an eligible third party generator within the meaning of Ontario Regulation 541/05 (Net Metering) made under the Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998. (Net Metering Regulation)

ASI SPE seeks to retail electricity generated by a renewable generation facility under power purchase agreements, including retailing to “eligible customers” as defined in the Net Metering Regulation and who enter into a net metering agreement with their electricity distributor.

This Decision and Order is being issued by the Delegated Authority without a hearing pursuant to section 6(4) of the OEB Act.

The OEB reminds ASI SPE that, as per section 6.1 of the OEB’s Electricity Retailer Code of Conduct (Code), ASI SPE is required to file with the OEB a certificate of compliance and receive from the OEB the written acknowledgement prior to commencing retailing activity. Further, the OEB reminds ASI SPE that where it is not acting as an eligible third party generator in a net metering arrangement, it must comply with all provisions of the Code, the ECPA and associated Regulations.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The application by ASI SPE 106 Inc. for an electricity retailer licence is granted, on such conditions as are contained in the attached licence.
