## DECISION AND ORDER

General Motors of Canada Company (General Motors) filed an application on November 13, 2025, with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) pursuant to section 60 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* (OEB Act), for renewal of its electricity wholesaler licence.

General Motor's electricity wholesaler licence EW-2020-0211 is set to expire on November 18, 2025, and the applicant has filed a request for an extension to the term of the licence, pending the final determination of its renewal application.

Considering the time required to process an application in accordance with the OEB's established practice and procedures, and considering the applicant's need for a licence to carry out activities as an electricity wholesaler, the OEB finds it expedient to extend the term of the existing licence, pending the final disposition of the matter. This Decision and Order does not constitute a final decision on the application.

### IT IS ORDERED THAT:

The term of General Motors of Canada Company's licence EW-2020-0211 is extended until February 14, 2026, or until the final determination of the electricity wholesaler licence application, whichever is earlier. The conditions of licence remain unchanged.
