Issues:

AMPCO's membership includes customers of the Applicant and are materially impacted by the application. This Application is Alectra Utilities' first rebasing application filed as an amalgamated entity. Alectra Utilities is seeking approval of a 2027 to 2031 custom rate framework which includes cost of service rebasing in 2027, followed by a Custom Price Cap Index (CPCI) applied in each of years two through five (2028-2031). The application includes a rate harmonization plan, a cost allocation study, a load forecast that considers the impact of electrification, a change in the rate design methodology for Standby Rates, updated asset useful lives and resulting depreciation rates, and disposal of Group 1 and Group 2 deferral and variance accounts. Alectra Utilities seeks a 2027 total revenue requirement of \$841.1 million which reflects a 43.4% increase since 2019 actuals. AMPCO has an interest in all issues included in the standard issues list for cost-based applications.

Mandate and Objectives:

AMPCO is a not-for-profit consumer interest advocacy organization. Its mission is industrial electricity rates that are affordable, competitive and fair.

Membership of the Intervenor and Constituency Represented:

AMPCO's members represent Ontario's major industries: forestry, chemical, mining and minerals, steel, petroleum products, cement, automotive and manufacturing and business consumers in general.

AMPCO members are major investors, major employers and a major part of the communities in which they operate, across Ontario. Membership is available for industrial companies with operations in Ontario and with minimum average monthly demand greater than or equal to 1 MW. AMPCO members generally account for approximately 15 TWh of industrial electricity demand in the province on an annual basis. AMPCO is the forum of choice for major power consumers who recognize that their business success depends on an affordable and reliable electricity system.

Programs or Activities Carried Out by the Intervenor:

In addition to intervention before administrative tribunals and related court proceedings, AMPCO's other activities include participation in electricity sector technical discussions and involvement in legislative proceedings and government policy consultations.

Governance Structure:

AMPCO is governed by a Board of Directors elected from its membership. The membership of the Board includes up to 15 Directors, one President (ex-officio) and one past Chair (ex-officio).

The Board of Directors meets approximately eight-ten times per year. The Board receives updates on regulatory items and provides direction to the President (and AMPCO's Regulatory

Consultant) on all major OEB Applications and Consultations in which AMPCO participates.
