## 1 OVERVIEW

This Decision and Order of the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) approves an application filed by Enbridge Gas Inc. (Enbridge Gas) for a new certificate of public convenience and necessity (certificate) for the Municipality of Casselman. This new certificate is required merely to reflect a change to the municipal name of the Municipality of Casselman.

## 2 CONTEXT AND PROCESS

Enbridge Gas filed an application on August 6, 2025, under section 8 of the *Municipal Franchises Act*. The application is for an order approving a new certificate of public convenience and necessity to construct works to supply natural gas in the Municipality of Casselman.

This Decision and Order is being issued by the Delegated Authority pursuant to section 6 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* (OEB Act). Because this is an administrative matter and no new rights are being granted to Enbridge Gas, the Delegated Authority has considered the application without holding a hearing pursuant to section 6(4) of the OEB Act.

### 3 APPLICATION

Enbridge Gas is a corporation incorporated under the laws of the Province of Ontario, with its head office in the City of Toronto and the Municipality of Chatham-Kent.

The Municipality of Casselman is a municipal corporation incorporated under the laws of the Province of Ontario. It is a lower-tier municipality located in the United Counties of Prescott and Russell. On June 11, 1888, the Village of Casselman separated from the Township of Cambridge and was incorporated. On July 9, 2019 the name of the Village of Casselman was changed to the Municipality of Casselman.

Enbridge Gas states that it holds a certificate dated May 5, 1995 for the Village of Casselman and that it is not aware of any changes to the boundaries of the Municipality of Casselman since the certificate was issued.<sup>1</sup>

In this application, Enbridge Gas requests an order of the OEB cancelling its existing certificate and granting it a new certificate to construct works to supply natural gas in the Municipality of Casselman as it is currently named.

Enbridge Gas holds a franchise agreement with the Municipality of Casselman that was effective September 8, 2015.<sup>2</sup> Enbridge Gas also has a franchise agreement with, and certificate for, the Municipality of Nation which surrounds the Municipality of Casselman.

Enbridge Gas is not aware of any other natural gas distributor in the areas within or adjacent to the Municipality of Casselman.

## 4 FINDINGS

The OEB finds that it is in the public interest to approve Enbridge Gas's application for a certificate for the Municipality of Casselman.

The OEB has considered this application without holding a hearing because Enbridge Gas did not seek, nor is being granted, any new rights in respect the Municipality of Casselman. Moreover, no other person's certificate rights are affected as a result of this decision.

The issuance of a new certificate for the Municipality of Casselman, aligned with its current name, is consistent with the intent of the OEB that certificate holders update their existing certificate(s) if the name of the municipality changes.<sup>3</sup> This is a housekeeping matter that merely reflects the change in the name of the municipality.

A new certificate, attached as Schedule A to this Decision and Order, is granted to Enbridge Gas for the Municipality of Casselman. The new certificate cancels and supersedes Enbridge Gas's prior certificate authorization for the Village of Casselman.

## 5 ORDER

### IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. A certificate of public convenience and necessity, attached as Schedule A, is granted to Enbridge Gas Inc. to construct works to supply natural gas in the Municipality of Casselman. A map of the Municipality of Casselman is attached as Schedule B.
2. This certificate of public convenience and necessity cancels and supersedes E.B.C. 215.
3. Enbridge Gas Inc. shall pay the OEB's costs of and incidental to this proceeding upon receipt of the OEB's invoice.

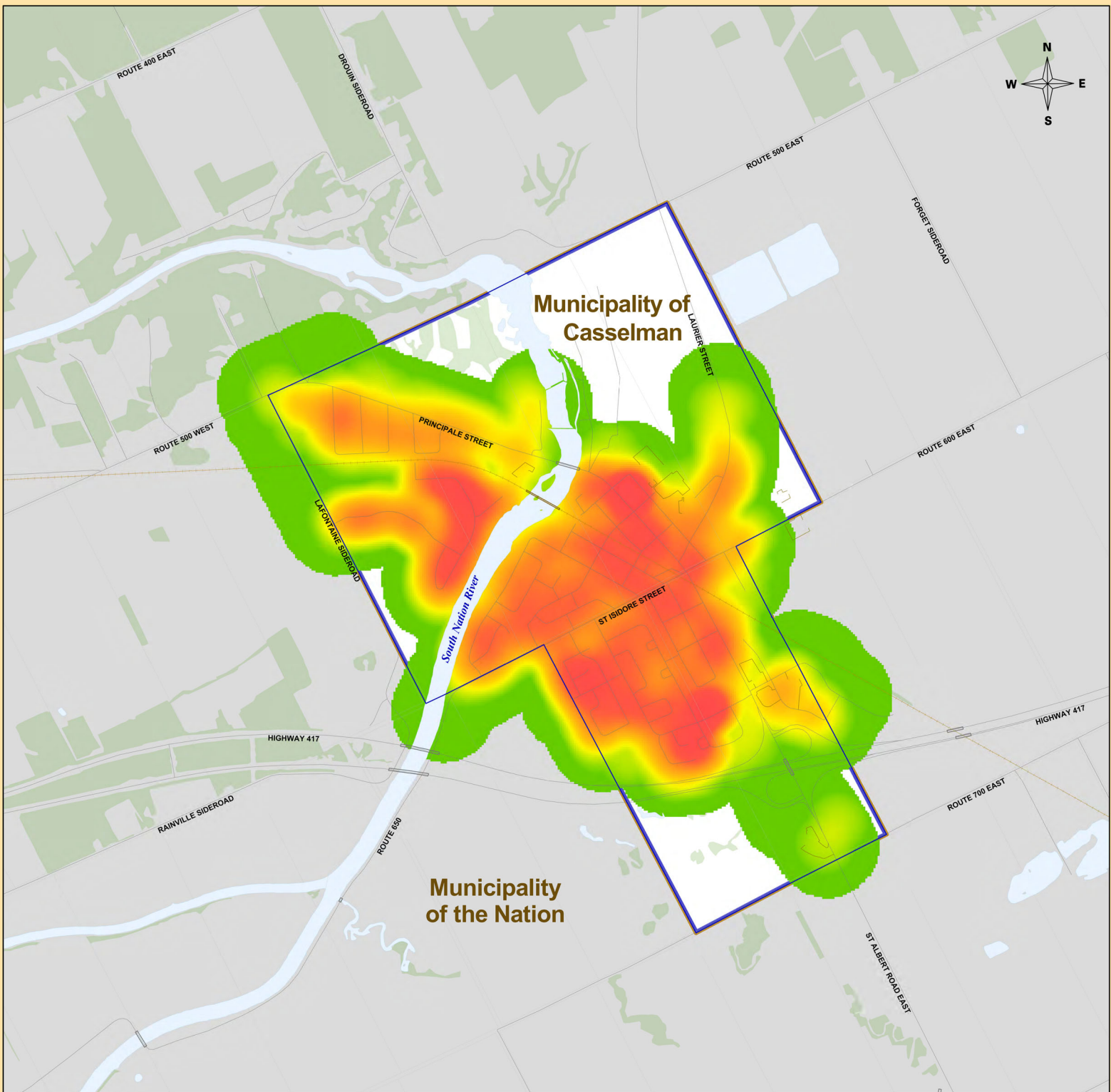
