**INTERIM DECISION AND ORDER**

Glencore Canada Corporation (GCC) filed an application on October 15, 2025, with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) pursuant to section 60 of *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* (OEB Act) for renewal of its electricity wholesaler licence. GCC's electricity wholesaler licence (EW-2020-0247) that was valid until November 25, 2025. Due to a technical issue, the OEB commenced processing the licence renewal application following the expiry of GCC's licence EW-2020-0247.

GCC's licence provides that the term may be extended by the OEB. As per section 57 of the OEB Act, no person can participate in the IESO-administered markets unless licensed to do so.

The OEB is extending the term of the existing licence on an interim basis, recognizing the applicant's need for its licence to continue carrying out activities as an electricity wholesaler, pending the final disposition of its licence renewal application. This Decision and Order does not constitute a final decision on the application.

**IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

1. The term of licence EW-2020-0247 is extended to March 1, 2026, or the date of a final determination of the electricity wholesaler licence application, whichever is earlier. All other conditions of licence EW-2020-0247 remain unchanged.
