Application for a Service Area Amendment

PROCEDURAL ORDER NO. 5

December 10, 2025

Wasaga Distribution Inc. (Wasaga Distribution) filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) on August 19, 2025, under section 74 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, to amend its licensed service area¹ to include a property located at 400 45th Street South, in the Town of Wasaga Beach, to its licensed territory. The subject property is currently part of Hydro One Networks Inc.'s (Hydro One) service area. The OEB is proceeding by way of a written hearing. Hydro One is an approved intervenor.

Wasaga Distribution and Hydro One filed responses to interrogatories related to their respective evidence on November 7, 2025.

On November 14, 2025, Hydro One filed a Notice of Motion requesting that the OEB order Wasaga Distribution to provide an answer or a complete answer to the following interrogatories: Hydro One-1(c), Hydro One-7(e), (f) and Hydro One-12(b). Wasaga Distribution filed a response to Hydro One's Notice of Motion on November 17, 2025.

On November 25, 2025, the OEB issued Procedural Order No. 4, in which the OEB directed Wasaga Distribution to file certain information with the OEB by November 27, 2025 and permitted Hydro One submit a reply to Wasaga Distribution's November 17, 2025, letter and to the OEB's requests for more information regarding interrogatories Hydro One-7 (e) and (f), and Hydro One-12 by December 2, 2025.

Wasaga Distribution filed its response to Procedural Order No. 4 on November 27, 2025, and Hydro One filed its response to Procedural Order No. 4 on December 2, 2025. In its December 2, 2025, letter, Hydro One requested that Wasaga Distribution update its response to Hydro One's interrogatory 1(d) to reflect information disclosed by Wasaga Distribution in response to Procedural Order No. 4, and that Wasaga Distribution respond to two additional questions set out in the December 2, 2025, Hydro One letter.

On December 4, 2025, Wasaga Distribution filed its response to Hydro One's December 2, 2025, correspondence. Wasaga Distribution submitted that Hydro One's requests for further answers related to Hydro One interrogatories should be denied. Wasaga Distribution also provided additional information related to Hydro One interrogatory 1(d) that it advised was inadvertently omitted from its earlier response to that interrogatory.

The OEB has reviewed the correspondence filed by Hydro One and Wasaga Distribution. This is Hydro One's motion, and accordingly, the OEB will permit Hydro One to submit a reply to Wasaga Distribution's letter dated December 4, 2025. The OEB will then consider and make its determination on Hydro One's motion.

The OEB is making provision for the following related to this proceeding. Further procedural orders may be issued by the OEB.

THE ONTARIO ENERGY BOARD ORDERS THAT:

1. Hydro One may submit a reply to Wasaga Distribution's December 4, 2025 letter by **December 12, 2025**.
