Re: EB-2025-0043 ENWIN Utilities Ltd. Application for 2026 Rates

The Ontario Energy Board (OEB) provided a draft Decision and Rate Order and a draft Tariff of Rates and Charges in relation to the above-noted proceeding on November 28, 2025. On December 2, 2025, in its comments on the drafts, ENWIN Utilities Ltd. (ENWIN) noted a change for the Principal Balance and Interest Balance for Table 6.1: Group 1 Deferral and Variance Account Balances, as well as four adjustments to the 2026 Rate Generator Model, including:

- In Tab 18 – Regulatory Charges: changing the unit of measurement of the Standard Supply Service – Administrative Charge to be the fixed “\$” charge, rather than the volumetric “\$/kWh” charge.
- In Tab 21 – Bill Impacts: updating the Current Loss Factor and Proposed Loss Factor for the Large Use – Regular and Dedicated Transformer station rate classes to the value of 1.0045.
- In Tab 21 – Bill Impacts: ensuring the formulas calculating the Total Bill on Non-RPP Average Price for the Residential Non-RPP (Retailer) and General Service Less than 50kW Non-RPP (Retailer) rate classes included the Ontario Electricity Rebate value.

All the changes noted by ENWIN were applied to the draft Decision and Order and 2026 Rate Generator Model.

The OEB has now issued a final Decision and Rate Order, together with a final Tariff of Rates and Charges. Copies of these documents are enclosed with this letter.
