Sample letter to the 10 customers that the applicants propose to transfer from Hydro One to Cornwall Electric

YOUR ELECTRICITY DISTRIBUTOR MAY BE CHANGING

Dear customer:

Your electricity distributor, Hydro One Networks Inc. ("Hydro One"), filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board requesting a transfer of your service to Cornwall Street Railway Light and Power Company Limited ("Cornwall Electric"). You are not required to take any action in response to this letter but you may wish to let the Ontario Energy Board know of any concerns you may have about the application.

As you know, you are currently a customer of Hydro One and receive your electricity bills from Hydro One. However, you may not know that your electricity is supplied by Cornwall Electric. You are within one electricity distributor's service area but are actually served electricity from a second electricity distributor. This arrangement is known as a long term load transfer.

The Ontario Energy Board requires electricity distributors to eliminate long term load transfer arrangements before January 31, 2009.

Both Hydro One and Cornwall Electric have applied to the Board for an order approving your transfer to Cornwall Electric. If the Board approves the transfer, you will become a customer of Cornwall Electric and your electricity rate may change – you will be supplied and billed by Cornwall Electric.

APPLICATION TO THE ONTARIO ENERGY BOARD BY YOUR ELECTRICITY DISTRIBUTOR EB-2008-0329

Dear customer:

Your electricity distributor, Cornwall Street Railway Light and Power Company Limited ("Cornwall Electric"), filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board requesting a continuation of the way in which your electricity is currently supplied. You are not required to take any action in response to this letter but you may wish to let the Ontario Energy Board know of any concerns you may have about the application.

As you know, you are currently a customer of Cornwall Electric and are billed for electricity by Cornwall Electric at its approved rates. However, you may not know that your electricity is supplied by Hydro One Networks Inc. ("Hydro One"). You are within one electricity distributor's service area but are actually served electricity by a second electricity distributor. This arrangement is known as a long term load transfer.

The Ontario Energy Board requires electricity distributors to eliminate long term load transfer arrangements before January 31, 2009. However, Cornwall Electric applied to the Board for an order allowing it to continue its long term load transfer arrangement with Hydro One for some customers beyond January 31, 2009 to allow Cornwall Electric to make necessary arrangements to supply those customers directly.

In your case, Cornwall Electric intends to supply you directly within approximately one year. Cornwall Electric would continue to serve your electricity needs, at the rates that are approved for Cornwall Electric, as is the case at present.
