**Re: EB-2025-0297 – 2027-2031 Payment Amounts Application**

Attached please find an application by Ontario Power Generation Inc. and DNNP LP by its general partner, DNNP GP Inc. for an order or orders approving payment amounts for prescribed generating facilities commencing January 1, 2027.<sup>1</sup>

In accordance with the Ontario Energy Board's ("OEB") Rules of Practice and Procedure ("Rules") and the OEB's Practice Direction on Confidential Filings (the "Practice Direction"), OPG confirms that its application filing was made in accordance with the Rules and the Practice Direction and that there is no personal information contained in the documents filed publicly that is not otherwise redacted. If any, such information is also identified in OPG's confidential filing submissions.

As Rule 9.03 regarding the use of Generative AI was not in place throughout most of the drafting process, OPG did not have specific procedures in place to verify compliance with the requirement for most of the drafting period. Pursuant to Rule 9.03, OPG confirms all portions of the application have been verified by OPG without the assistance of Generative AI.

OPG is filing this application in accordance with the OEB's performance standards for cost-based applications with a revenue requirement greater than \$500M.
