**Re: Enbridge Gas Inc. (Enbridge Gas or the Company)  
 Ontario Energy Board (OEB) File: EB-2024-0325  
 Glendale Community Expansion Project (the Project)  
 Project Design Refinements**

---

On November 11, 2024, Enbridge Gas filed an application pursuant to subsection 95(2) of the Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998 for an order exempting the Company from the requirement to obtain leave to construct for natural gas pipelines and facilities in the community of Glendale Subdivision in the Township of South Glengarry, in the United Counties of Stormont, Dundas and Glengarry (the Project). On December 18, 2025, the OEB granted an order exempting Enbridge Gas from the requirement to obtain leave to construct the Project, subject to conditions outlined in Schedule A of the Decision and Order.

Although there is no condition requiring OEB approval for change requests, condition 1 requires that “Enbridge Gas shall construct the facilities... in accordance with its application and the evidence filed in EB-2024-0325.” Since filing the application, Enbridge Gas has advanced its detailed design for the Project and has identified three minor design refinements and one clerical error. Enbridge Gas wishes to advise the OEB of these changes, as outlined below:

Item	Change
1	A change in pipeline material for the Highway 401 crossing from 4-inch PE to 4-inch ST due to the presence of boulders identified during the recently completed Geo Tech analysis.
2	Removal of 130 m of 2” PE IP pipe along Poirier Ave between Hickory Street and Glen Road to avoid impacting a built heritage resource located at 6103 Poirier Ave.
3	Removal of 37 m of 2” PE IP pipe at a water crossing on Huron Street as it is no longer required.
4	Correction to pipe length required due to the identification of some lengths of pipe that were inadvertently double counted in the original filed estimate of pipe lengths.

Collectively, these changes result in a net reduction in pipeline length required from approximately 5.6 km to approximately 4.7 km. The changes have no impact on the need for the project and there is no net change to project costs or economics. Because there are no changes to the remaining pipeline route, there are no impacts on Indigenous peoples and their

rights, or on other landowners or municipalities.

The changes may result in positive environmental impacts due to the removal of pipe in potentially sensitive areas as described above, however Enbridge Gas is not proposing to make any changes to the environmental mitigations outlined in the Environmental Report.

Attachment 1 is an updated map of the Project, reflecting the changes noted above.


