Dear OEB,

We received procedural order one, dated January 9, 2026, and are pleased to have been approved as an intervenor with cost eligibility.

Now that intervenor status has been granted, I need to obtain Elected Council's approval to retain legal counsel.

The first opportunity for me to do so is a council meeting on January 26, 2026, but the order contains four numerated orders with deadlines, the first of which is January 23, 2026. As it is not possible for us to meet those deadlines, I am requesting an extension of the deadlines set out in the notice.

If OEB is agreeable, I will communicate with the board in early February, once a lawyer has been retained and apprised about the case, so new deadlines can be established.
