Re: Request for Extension, Enbridge Gas Inc., Cedar Springs Community Expansion Project, EB-2025-0313

Dear OEB,

We received a Notice of Hearing on December 15, 2025.

The following day, I sent two concerns to OEB: "I could not locate the project in OEB's RDS by file number or title" and "I see the OEB # is the same as Enbridge's Port Colborne Reinforcement Project. Am I right to assume this is an error?"

Replying the same day, OEB said "This was an error. We will be sending the corrected Notice a little later. The EB number should be EB-2025-0313. Our apologies for the error."

But I still couldn't locate project documents by number or title.

On January 9, 2026, I wrote: "I'm still having trouble finding the app through OEB's system, with no hits for the file number or title. Please assist."

OEB responded the same day, "Due to an administrative error the documents were not available on RDS. The error has since been resolved and documents are now available on RDS. Here is the link to the documents for this proceeding."

I replied January 12, 2026: "As the documents were supposed to be available almost a month ago, but have only become available now, shouldn't the filing deadline be pushed back a corresponding amount of time?"

To date, no response has been received. After speaking to another OEB contact, I was informed a formal extension request would be required, thus this letter. I find it unethical that OEB did not respond to my January 12, 2026 email with that information. First Nations already have a starkly unequal playing field vs. development proponents in OEB processes, and such actions further those advantages.

I am formally requesting that the deadline for the Notification Letter be changed from January 14, 2026 to mid-February 2026, with the start of the period coinciding with my reading of OEB's January 9, 2026 email, saying the documents were now accessible, on January 12, 2026.
