**Re: Hydro One Networks Inc.
Welland Thorold Project - Leave to Construct and Expropriation
Application

This letter is in response to your January 21, 2026 email in your capacity as Counsel for Nyon Oil Inc. and 1170367 Ontario Inc. (collectively “Nyon and 1170367”) to the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) with respect to the above-noted proceeding. In the email, Nyon and 1170367 requested from the OEB an extension until January 30, 2026 (“extension”) to respond to Hydro One Networks Inc.’s (“Hydro One”) objection to Nyon and 1170367’s requests for intervenor status (“objection letter”).

The OEB approves Nyon and 1170367’s request for the extension. The OEB notes that Hydro One did not serve Nyon and 1170367 with the objection letter within 5 calendar days of the intervention deadline as required by Rule 22.04 of the OEB’s Rules of Practice and Procedure. The OEB finds that the time extension requested by Nyon and 1170367 is appropriate in the circumstances.

Background

On January 16, 2026, Hydro One filed a letter with the OEB objecting to Nyon and 1170367’s intervention requests. In the objection letter, Hydro One submitted that, should the OEB decide to grant Nyon and 1170367 participatory rights, these rights should be limited and cost eligibility not awarded.¹

On January 20, 2026, the OEB received an email from Nyon and 1170367 indicating that it had not received the objection letter. It further noted that the proceeding was not (at the time) listed on the “Major Applications” or “Section 92 Leave to Construct” headings on the OEB’s website.²

In response, Hydro One acknowledged by email on January 20, 2026, that it had not initially copied Nyon and 1170367 on the filing of the objection letter, and provided a copy of the objection letter.³

On January 21, 2026, Counsel for Nyon and 1170367 requested that the OEB grant Nyon and 1170367 an extension until January 30, 2026 to respond to the objection letter. In support of its request, Nyon and 1170367 Counsel noted the delayed receipt of the objection letter and Hydro One’s substantive submissions in it.⁴

The OEB requires Nyon and 1170367 to file, and serve on Hydro One, its written submissions in response to Hydro One’s objection letter by **January 30, 2026**. Hydro One’s reply submissions, if any, are required by **February 4, 2026**.
