**Re: EB-2025-0297 – Ontario Power Generation and DNNP LP Payment Amounts Application**

On behalf of the Quinte Manufacturers Association (QMA), I am writing to formally request intervenor status in the Ontario Energy Board's proceeding regarding Ontario Power Generation's (OPG) Application to set payment amounts for regulated hydroelectric and nuclear generating stations effective January 1 2027, as described in the Board's recently posted Notice of a Hearing on this matter.

QMA is an unfunded, industry-led association representing manufacturers and related companies across the Greater Bay of Quinte region which includes the cities of Belleville, Quinte West and the municipality of Brighton. Our membership spans a diverse industrial sector—from large multinational corporations to small and medium-sized enterprises—reflecting the full spectrum of manufacturing activity in the area.

Manufacturing and related industries are the economic backbone of our region, generating over \$6 billion of the Bay of Quinte's \$12 billion total economic output. More than 11,000 people are employed in these sectors, making energy affordability and reliability critical to sustaining jobs, investment, and long-term growth.

Given the direct and material impact that OPG's payment amount rates will have on our members' operations and competitiveness through to December 31, 2031, the QMA has a substantial interest in the outcome of this proceeding. We intend to participate actively in the review process, including examining evidence, submitting any necessary interrogatories, and providing comments or arguments as appropriate. The QMA also requests to be made eligible for an award of its reasonably incurred costs to participate in this proceeding.
