I am an Ontario ratepayer with more than twenty years of senior professional experience within Ontario Power Generation Inc. (OPG) and its subsidiary Laurentis Energy Partners (LEP). My roles included executive responsibility and oversight of enterprise infrastructure, capital projects, facilities & projects and enterprise support services, with direct involvement in cost structures, capital governance processes, safety-related remediation activities, subsidiary start-up (LEP) launch, and internal cost allocation methodologies relevant to the matters before the Board.

Membership of the Intervenor and Constituency Represented:

The intervenor is an individual Ontario ratepayer participating in his personal capacity. He does not represent an organization or formal constituency. His participation is informed by professional experience in the Ontario electricity sector and is intended to assist the Board in assessing matters of prudence, governance, and ratepayer protection.

Programs or Activities Carried Out by the Intervenor:

The intervenor is an individual Ontario ratepayer who now engages in independent review and analysis of public-interest matters in the energy and nuclear sector. His activities include reviewing regulatory filings and supporting evidence, assessing governance and cost allocation practices, and providing informed input to regulatory processes based exclusively on first hand professional experience in operations management, capital programs, and enterprise support services.

Issues:

As an Ontario ratepayer, the intervenor is materially impacted by the proceeding through the potential effect of the proposed payment amounts on electricity rates and the allocation of costs to regulated operations. The intervenor’s interest is in ensuring that costs proposed for recovery are prudently incurred, transparently allocated, and supported by appropriate governance and internal controls. The intervenor expects to focus on issues related to support

services and shared services cost allocation, including arrangements involving Laurentis Energy Partners; capital governance and capitalization practices for support services and contractor labour embedded in capital projects; the prudence and timing of safety-related remediation costs; value-for-money considerations associated with shared services and internal service arrangements; and the effectiveness of governance and internal control frameworks as they relate to cost recovery and ratepayer protection. At this stage, the intervenor does not identify any additional issues beyond those contemplated in the proceeding but reserves the right to seek clarification or raise related matters should gaps or inconsistencies emerge in the evidentiary record

Policy Interests:

The intervenor does not primarily represent a policy interest. He is participating as an individual Ontario ratepayer with a direct interest in the prudence, transparency, and governance of costs proposed for recovery from ratepayers. To the extent that broader considerations are relevant, the intervenor's interest aligns with the Board's statutory objectives of protecting the interests of consumers with respect to prices and the reliability and quality of electricity service. This interest relates to issues concerning cost allocation, capital governance, remediation prudence, and internal controls, as these matters directly affect the appropriateness of the proposed payment amounts and their impact on ratepayers.

Hearings:

At this stage, the intervenor does not have a preference for a specific form of hearing and defers to the Board's determination of the most appropriate hearing format. The intervenor anticipates that the issues identified can be addressed through the hearing process established by the Board and reserves the right to comment on hearing format should the scope or complexity of the proceeding evolve.

Evidence:

The intervenor is unable to confirm at this time whether he intends to file evidence in the proceeding. The need for evidence will depend on the scope of issues that remain in dispute following the exchange of information and the development of the evidentiary record.

Coordination with Other Intervenors:

At this stage, the intervenor is not aware of the identities or interests of other intervenors in this proceeding. The intervenor intends to review the service list once established and will make reasonable efforts to coordinate with any intervenors with similar interests, as appropriate, to avoid duplication of effort. The intervenor anticipates that coordination, if required, would focus on issue scoping and the sequencing of questions or submissions.
